This letter comes to you with good news. April 27, 1999 @ 4:00 p.m. Governor Gary Locke signed into law SSB 5729, "Landfill location" that permanently bans all dumps over an aquifer. However, LRI Inc. is now claiming they have secured all required permits and began construction at 3:00 p.m. on April 27 at the 304th St. sight. If this is true, it will now be settled in court. It has been a long hard tight with LRI, Inc. and the battle may not be over. However, we will continue to work toward a positive outcome.

This bill will prohibit any future landfills from being developed over a sole source aquifer. Which in itself is a great victory for generations to come.

We could not have accomplished this task alone. I, Senator Rasmussen, Representative Roger Bush, and the concerned citizens of the group CROWD, lead by Viki Steiner, have all worked relentlessly to defeat this toxic dump and keep it **from** being located over our sole source aquifer. We will continue to **keep** up the good fight.
